There are 4 categories for Miss, Ms and Mrs. Contestants and 3 categories for Teen Contestants that will be judged by a panel of judges to determine the titleholders.

**Sense of Style Competition –** This category requires a nice outfit that represents the contestant's sense of style. Many contestants choose to wear a cocktail dress. It should fit well, look nice, be tasteful, and eye-catching. This portion is judged on stage during the pageant.
